Experienced aid workers who may be deployed to missions with high threat environments (HTEs).

GOAL

To equip participants with a range of skills suited to deal with a variety of risks common to high threats environments. At the end of this training, participants will be familiar with:

- How to mitigate impact of threats common to HTEs.
- How to react under high stress environment and adapt their personal security strategies accordingly.
- All First Aid and TECC certification related skills.

Awareness

of the practical realities of high threat environments, with a strong focus on stress, and situational awareness.

Knowledge

To increase participants' understanding of good practices when facing day-to-day security risks.

Skills

To strengthen the techniques and tools that everyone needs to master in order to analyse the risks present in their environment and develop means of mitigation so as to be able to react to emergency situations.

THE TRAINING TAKES PLACE ON THE BASIS OF A GLOBAL SCENARIO WHICH REPRESENTS THE DEPLOYMENT OF A TEAM OF AID WORKERS, THE PARTICIPANTS, TO A FICTITIOUS COUNTRY, LEMURIA, IN A DIFFICULT SITUATION WHICH IS RAPIDLY DETERIORATING.

THE TRAINING CONSISTS OF A SET OF THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL MODULES AS WELL AS NUMEROUS ADVANCED SIMULATIONS. THE MODULES DEAL WITH THE MAIN TOPICS OF PERSONAL SECURITY. IN ADDITION, MANY CROSS-CUTTING TOPICS ARE COVERED DIRECTLY DURING THE SIMULATIONS, EACH OF WHICH IS PREPARED, PRACTISED AND DEBRIEFED.
